

Title: Introduction to Close Protection

Aims: To train participants in skills required for working as a close protection officer

Objectives: Explore roles and responsibilities of close protection
Develop Conflict management skills
Learn operational planning / risk assessments
Develop CQC – close quarter combat

Commentary

This is an intensive weekend residential course that covers all the basic aspects of close protection work. The skills are taught by specialist in the field drawn from military, emergency services and enforcement agencies.

Candidates will learn a range of skills from unarmed combat, to planning and risk assessments. As part of the assessment candidates must be able to plan, implement and adapt to a realistic training scenario, as well as apply emergency 1st Aid.
